

Hyperacusis

Describes the experience of some people for whom even quite modest environmental sounds appear loud, intrusive and sometimes painful

Phonophobia

Sensitivity is specific to a particular sound or sounds, and people then have an aversion or anxiety related to those sounds

Misophonia

The intense dislike or even repulsion that some people with hyperacusis experience to a particular sound

Recruitment

An altered sound tolerance in people who have a hearing loss

HYPERACUSIS

Hyperacusis is a hearing disorder characterized by an increased sensitivity to certain frequencies and volume ranges of sound. Specifically, an abnormally reduced tolerance of everyday sounds.

Sounds can sometimes be perceived as painful or uncomfortably loud.
